The Partnership for Prescription Assistance (PPA) delivers hope to millions of patients in need.



Since 2005, PPA has helped connect nearly **10 million patients** to public and private patient assistance programs.



Sponsored by America's biopharmaceutical research companies, PPA is a **free, confidential service** that helps connect uninsured and underinsured patients to programs that provide prescription medicines for free or nearly free.



PPA also has a section on how uninsured patients can access information about health care coverage along with interactive content on how to improve health for Americans of all ages.



Programs listed in PPA offer access to more than **2,500 prescription medicines**, including a wide range of generics.



Each month, more than **60,000 people** visit PPA's easy-to-use website (www.pparx.org) to find patient assistance programs.



Through the online free clinic finder, PPA has connected more than **one million people with free health care clinics** throughout the United States.



The PPA website also designates specific pages to **hearing and animal assistance programs, HIV/AIDS programs and diabetes programs and supplies.**
